

Primary French Key Stage 2 Scheme of Work Resources and Planning

There are sufficient 30-45 minute detailed lesson plans to teach a weekly lesson throughout Years 3 to 6. The lesson plans reference the interactive Smart Notebook resources which include integrated sound files for all vocabulary; scanned storybooks read by native speakers; audio versions of the finger rhymes; interactive language games; templates for all classroom activity resources and printable workbooks. The assessment targets for each lesson are highlighted in the lesson plans.

The language content is taught progressively over the four years of Key Stage 2 and meets the attainment targets of the KS2 Programme of Study for Languages. This includes grammar, phonics, dictionary skills and high frequency vocabulary. The language progression was inspired by that of the *Catherine Cheater* French Scheme of Work. The method of teaching phonics, known as 'Physical French Phonics', has been integrated within the scheme. The plans and resources have been tried and tested extensively with primary colleagues, both specialist and non-specialist and proved to be very effective.
