Interplay of grammar, phonics and vocabulary In KS2 curriculum design

- Examine the content, progression and delivery of grammar and phonics in KS2 curriculum design
- Consider how to select and recycle vocabulary
- Demonstrate how the interplay of grammar, phonics and vocabulary supports the development of the four language skills

Plan, Assess, Progress

- Consider how to teach a language progressively over 4 years to meet the stated targets of the KS2 Programme of Study
- A wide range of classroom activities will be demonstrated for each year group which meet these targets (examples in French but could be adapted for other languages)
- How to monitor and record progress using a simple classroom assessment method through the delivery of these activities

Teaching Phonics in KS2 French Lessons

- Consider the importance of the inclusion and explicit teaching of phonics in KS2 foreign language lessons
- Explain a method and process of teaching phonics in a primary classroom
- Demonstrate classroom activities to teach phonics (examples in French but suitable for other languages)
- Suggest ways to get started in teaching phonics

2.5 hours Half Day

Mapping progression in primary language lessons

- Consider how to ensure that your primary languages curriculum is ambitious and coherently planned and sequenced
- Examine the attainment targets of the KS2 Programme of Study
- Suggest what language learning looks like in each year group of KS2
- Discuss how to select the content of a scheme of work to ensure substantial progress
- Explore ways to assess and record progress

- Discuss how to design a vision of language learning to share with the school community

- Ensure the delivery of language lessons meet the demands of a high-quality languages education in terms of methodology, content, resources and activities
- Examine methods to monitor and record the progress of learning
- Consider how to establish and raise the profile of languages as a foundation subject in the primary curriculum
