#### **Combined Language and Pedagogical Training Course in Berlin**

This course is for teachers with little or no prior knowledge of German and is aimed at non-specialist primary school teachers and is offered by the Goethe Institut. The aims of the course are:

- an introduction to state of the art methods and teaching material for teaching German at primary school level with a focus on interactive and communication oriented teaching methods
- the improvement of language skills
- the deepening of historical and cultural knowledge about Germany relevant to primary school children

In addition to a visit to Berlin, there is online training. Scholarships are available and the closing date for making an application is the 15<sup>th</sup> September.
