ALL Primary Languages Conference Online

The fourth annual ALL Primary Languages Conference Online will take place on Saturday 4th November 2023 9.00am-3.00pm. The theme of the conference is 'Moving On'. The invited speakers, who are all involved in the delivery of a high-quality primary languages education, will share: how they move on children in their learning of a language; develop the teaching expertise of class teachers; their research on what progression looks like; how to build on prior learning with secondary schools. The HMI, Bianka Zemke, OFSTED Lead for Languages, will deliver the keynote speech on what a high-quality primary languages curriculum might look like.
