## KEY STAGE 2 FRENCH METHODOLOGY

For anyone teaching French to children in Key Stage 2.

### Key Stage 2 Scheme of Work

## FRENCH LINGUISTIC UP-SKILLING

For anyone work who lacks confidence in their French pronunciation and knowledge of grammar. Suitable for complete beginners as well as those with 'rusty' language skills.

### French Phonics and Pronunciation
